David, obviously a great composer in his own right, comes from a veritable film composition dynasty. David is the son of legendary Hollywood composer Alfred Newman, brother of Thomas Newman and a cousin of Randy Newman.

David who has been using a ViPRE for sometime to record percussion and his priceless violins from his collection. David recently chose to add another and make it a stereo pair! "I love to record my violins and percussion elements with the ViPRE. It captures the sound of the rosin and strings extremely well, and I use it with my Wes Dooley RCA 77 a lot. We are thinking of getting the ViPRE 50 ohm modification especially to use with that mic to record my violin. We have been recording my percussionist Billy Sullivan's hand percussion with the ViPRE and a GT-67 for some time now".
